Q. 14. What is sin?

A. Sin is any want of conformity to, or transgression of the law of God.

A. The covenant being made with Adam, not only for himself but for his posterity, all mankind descending from him by ordinary generation, sinned in him, and fell with him in his first transgression.

Q. 16. Into what estate did the fall bring mankind?
