Q. 9. What is the work of creation?

A. The work of creation is God’s making all things of nothing, by the Word of his power, in six normal consecutive days, and all very good.

Q. 10. How did God create man?

A. God created man, male and female, after his own image, in knowledge, righteousness, and holiness with dominion over the creatures.

Q. 11. What are God’s works of providence?

A. God’s works of providence are his most holy, wise, and powerful, preserving and governing all his creatures, and all their actions.

Q. 12. What special act of providence did God exercise toward man in the state wherein he was created?

A. When God had created man, he entered into a covenant of life with him, upon condition of perfect obedience; forbidding him to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, upon pain of death.
