**Spurgeon's Catechism** Pastor Boeshaar

**Q. 20.** Who is the Redeemer of God's elect?

**A. The only Redeemer of God's elect is the Lord Jesus Christ, who being the eternal Son of God, became man, and so was and continues to be God and man, in two distinct natures and one person forever.**

**Q. 21.** How did Christ, being the Son of God, become man?

**A. Christ, the son of God, became man by taking to himself a true body, and a reasonable soul, being conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit in the Virgin Mary, and born of her, yet without sin.**

**Q. 22.** What offices does Christ execute as our Redeemer?

**A. Christ as our Redeemer executes the offices of a prophet, of a priest, and of a king, both in his state of humiliation and exaltation.**

<sup>12</sup> *There is* a generation *that is* pure in its own eyes, *Yet* is not washed from its filthiness. <sup>13</sup> *There is* a generation—oh, how lofty are their eyes! And their eyelids are lifted up. <sup>14</sup> *There is* a generation whose teeth *are like* swords, And whose fangs *are like* knives, To devour the poor from off the earth, And the needy from *among* men.

<sup>18</sup> There are three *things which* are too wonderful for me, Yes, four *which* I do not understand: <sup>19</sup> The way of an eagle in the air, The way of a serpent on a rock, The way of a ship in the midst of the sea, And the way of a man with a virgin. <sup>20</sup> This *is* the way of an adulterous woman: She eats and wipes her mouth, And says, “I have done no wickedness.”

<sup>33</sup> **Whoever seeks to save his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life will preserve it.** <sup>34</sup> **I tell you, in that night there will be two *men* in one bed: the one will be taken and the other will be left.** <sup>35</sup> **Two *women* will be grinding together: the one will be taken and the other**

left. <sup>36</sup> **Two *men* will be in the field: the one will be taken and the other left.”**
