<sup>16</sup>“So it was, when all the men of war had finally perished from among the people, <sup>17</sup>that the LORD spoke to me, saying: <sup>18</sup>“**This day you are to cross over at Ar, the boundary of Moab. <sup>19</sup>And *when* you come near the people of Ammon, do not harass them or meddle with them, for I will not give you *any* of the land of the people of Ammon *as* a possession, because I have given it to the descendants of Lot *as* a possession.”**

<sup>20</sup>(That was also regarded as a land of giants; giants formerly dwelt there. But the Ammonites call them Zamzumim, <sup>21</sup>a people as great and numerous and tall as the Anakim. **But the LORD destroyed them before them, and they dispossessed them and dwelt in their place, <sup>22</sup>just as He had done for the descendants of Esau, who dwelt in Seir, when He destroyed the Horites from before them. They dispossessed them and dwelt in their place, even to this day.** <sup>23</sup>And the Avim, who dwelt in villages as far as Gaza—the Caphtorim, who came from Caphtor, destroyed them and dwelt in their place.)

<sup>27</sup>Then some of the Sadducees, who deny that there is a resurrection, came to *Him* and asked *Him*, <sup>28</sup>saying: **“Teacher, Moses wrote to us *that* if a man's brother dies, having a wife, and he dies without children, his brother should take his wife and raise up offspring for his brother. <sup>29</sup>Now there were seven brothers. And the first took a wife, and died without children. <sup>30</sup>And the second took her as wife, and he died childless. <sup>31</sup>Then the third took her, and in like manner the seven also; and they left no children, and died. <sup>32</sup>Last of all the woman died also. <sup>33</sup>Therefore, in the resurrection, whose wife does she become? For all seven had her as wife.”**

<sup>34</sup>Jesus answered and said to them, “The sons of this age marry and are given in marriage. <sup>35</sup>But those who are counted worthy to attain that age, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry nor are given in marriage; <sup>36</sup>nor can they die anymore, for they are equal to the angels and are sons of God,

being sons of the resurrection. <sup>37</sup>But even Moses showed in the *burning bush passage* that the dead are raised, when he called the Lord ‘the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.’ <sup>38</sup>For He is not the God of the dead but of the living, for all live to Him.”

<sup>39</sup>Then some of the scribes answered and said, “Teacher, You have spoken well.” <sup>40</sup>But after that they dared not question Him anymore.
