### SPURGEON'S CATECHISM

PASTOR WOODY

Q. 49. Which is the fourth commandment?

A. The fourth commandment is, “Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labor, and do all thy work: but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates. For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it.”

Q. 50. What is required in the fourth commandment?

A. The fourth commandment requires the keeping holy to God such set times as he has appointed in his Word, expressly one whole day in seven, to be a holy Sabbath to himself.

Q. 51. How is the Sabbath to be sanctified?

A. The Sabbath is to be sanctified by a holy resting all that day, even from such worldly employments and recreations as are lawful on other days, and spending the whole time in the public and private exercises of God's worship, except so much as is taken up in the works of necessity and mercy.

### OLD TESTAMENT READING: DEUT. 4:15-24

<sup>15</sup>“Take careful heed to yourselves, for you saw no form when the Lord spoke to you at Horeb out of the midst of the fire, <sup>16</sup>lest you act corruptly and make for yourselves a carved image in the form of any figure: the likeness of male or female, <sup>17</sup>the likeness of any animal that *is* on the earth or the likeness of any winged bird that flies in the air, <sup>18</sup>the likeness of anything that creeps on the ground or the likeness of any fish that *is* in the water beneath the earth. <sup>19</sup>**And *take heed*, lest you lift your eyes to heaven, and *when* you see the sun, the moon, and the stars, all the host of heaven, you feel driven to worship them and serve them, which the Lord your God has given to all the peoples under the whole heaven as a heritage.** <sup>20</sup>But the Lord has taken you and brought you out of the iron furnace, out of Egypt, to be His people, an inheritance, as you are this day. <sup>21</sup>Furthermore the Lord was angry with me for your sakes, and swore that I would not cross over the Jordan, and that I would not enter the good land which the Lord your God is giving you as an inheritance. <sup>22</sup>But I must die in this land, I must not cross over the Jordan; but you shall cross over and possess that good land. <sup>23</sup>Take heed to yourselves, lest you forget the covenant of the Lord your God which He made with you, and make for yourselves a carved image in the form of anything which the Lord your God has forbidden you. <sup>24</sup>For the Lord your God *is* a consuming fire, a jealous God.
