Q. 52. Which is the fifth commandment?

A. The fifth commandment is, “Honor thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.”

Q. 53. What is required in the fifth commandment?

A. The fifth commandment requires the preserving the honor, and performing the duties belonging to every one in their various positions and relationships as superiors.

Q. 54. What is the reason annexed to the fifth commandment?

A. The reason annexed to the fifth commandment is, a promise of long life and prosperity—as far as it shall serve for God’s glory, and their own good—to all such as keep this commandment.
