**SPURGEON’S CATECHISM** PASTOR WOODY

**Q. 69.** What is faith in Jesus Christ?

**A. Faith in Jesus Christ is a saving grace, whereby we receive, and rest upon him alone for salvation, as he is set forth in the gospel.**

**Q. 70.** What is repentance to life?

**A. Repentance to life is a saving grace, whereby a sinner, out of a true sense of his sins, and apprehension of the mercy of God in Christ, does with grief and hatred of his sin turn from it to God, with full purpose to strive after new obedience.**

**Q. 71.** What are the outward means whereby the Holy Spirit communicates to us the benefits of redemption?

**A. The outward and ordinary means whereby the Holy Spirit communicates to us the benefits of Christ’s redemption, are the Word, by which souls are begotten to spiritual life; Baptism, the Lord’s Supper, Prayer, and Meditation, by all which believers are further edified in their most holy faith.**

<sup>10</sup> “So it shall be, when the Lord your God brings you into the land of which He swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give you large and beautiful cities which you did not build, <sup>11</sup> houses full of all good things, which you did not fill, hewn-out wells which you did not dig, vineyards and olive trees which you did not plant—when you have eaten and are full— <sup>12</sup> **then beware, lest you forget the Lord who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.** <sup>13</sup> **You shall fear the Lord your God and serve Him, and shall take oaths in His name.** <sup>14</sup> **You shall not go after other gods, the gods of the peoples who *are* all around you** <sup>15</sup> **(for the Lord your God *is* a jealous God among you), lest the anger of the Lord your God be aroused against you and destroy you from the face of the earth.**

<sup>20</sup> Pilate, therefore, wishing to release Jesus, again called out to them. <sup>21</sup> **But they shouted, saying, “Crucify *Him*, crucify *Him*!”**

<sup>22</sup> Then he said to them the third time, “Why, what evil has He done? I have found no reason for death in *Him*. I will therefore chastise *Him* and let *Him* go.”

<sup>23</sup> **But they were insistent, demanding with loud voices that He be crucified. And the voices of these men and of the chief priests prevailed.** <sup>24</sup> **So Pilate gave sentence that it should be as they requested.** <sup>25</sup> **And he released to them the one they requested, who for rebellion and murder had been thrown into prison; but he delivered Jesus to their will.**

<sup>26</sup> Now as they led *Him* away, they laid hold of a certain man, Simon a Cyrenian, who was coming from the country, and on him they laid the cross that he might bear *it* after Jesus.
