SPURGEON’S CATECHISM

PASTOR WOODY

Q. 72. How is the Word made effective to salvation?

A. The Spirit of God makes the reading, but especially the preaching, of the Word an effective means of convicting and converting sinners, and of building them up in holiness and comfort, through faith to salvation.

Q. 73. How is the Word to be read and heard that it may become effective for salvation?

A. That the Word may become effective to salvation, we must attend to it with preparation, and prayer, receive it with faith, and love, lay it up in our hearts, and practice it in our lives.

Q. 74. How do Baptism and the Lord’s Supper become spiritually helpful?

A. Baptism and the Lord’s Supper become spiritually helpful, not from any virtue in them, or in him who administers them, but only by the blessing of Christ, and the working of the Spirit in those who by faith receive them.
