<sup>1</sup>Lord, I cry out to You; Make haste to me! Give ear to my voice when I cry out to You. <sup>2</sup>Let my prayer be set before You *as* incense, The lifting up of my hands *as* the evening sacrifice.

<sup>3</sup>**Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth; Keep watch over the door of my lips. <sup>4</sup>Do not incline my heart to any evil thing, to practice wicked works with men who work iniquity; and do not let me eat of their delicacies.**

**HEIDELBERG CATECHISM** PASTOR WOODY

**Q. 1. What is your only comfort in life and in death?**

**A. That I am not my own, but belong—body and soul, in life and in death—to my faithful Savior, Jesus Christ. He has fully paid for all my sins with his precious blood, and has set me free from the tyranny of the devil. He also watches over me in such a way that not a hair can fall from my head without the will of my Father in heaven; in fact, all things must work together for my salvation. Because I belong to him, Christ, by his Holy Spirit, assures me of eternal life and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for him.**

**Q. 2. What must you know to live and die in the joy of this comfort?**

**A. Three things: first, how great my sin and misery are; second, how I am set free from all my sins and misery; third, how I am to thank God for such deliverance.**

**OLD TESTAMENT READING: DEUT. 10:1-9** TIM STEURER

<sup>1</sup>“At that time the Lord said to me, ‘Hew for yourself two tablets of stone like the first, and come up to Me on the mountain and make yourself an ark of wood. <sup>2</sup>And I will write on the tablets the words that were on the first tablets, which you broke; and you shall put them in the ark.’ <sup>3</sup>“So I made an ark of acacia wood, hewed two tablets of stone like the first, and went up the mountain, having the two tablets in my hand. <sup>4</sup>And He wrote on the tablets according to the first writing, the Ten Commandments, which the Lord had spoken to you in the mountain from the midst of the fire in the day of the assembly; and the Lord gave them to me. <sup>5</sup>Then I turned and came down from the mountain, and put the tablets in the ark which I had made; and there they are, just as the Lord commanded me.” <sup>6</sup>(Now the children of Israel journeyed from the wells of Bene Jaakan to Moserah, where Aaron died, and where he was buried; and Eleazar his son ministered as priest in his stead. <sup>7</sup>From there they journeyed to Gudgodah, and from Gudgodah to Jotbathah, a land of rivers of water. <sup>8</sup>**At that time the Lord separated the tribe of Levi to bear the ark of the covenant of the Lord, to stand before the Lord to minister to Him and to bless in His name, to this day. <sup>9</sup>Therefore Levi has no portion nor inheritance with his brethren; the Lord *is* his inheritance, just as the Lord your God promised him.)**

**NEW TESTAMENT READING: 1 JOHN 2:7-17** TIM STEURER

<sup>7</sup>Brethren, I write no new commandment to you, but an old commandment which you have had from the beginning. The old commandment is the word which you heard from the beginning. <sup>8</sup>Again, a new commandment I write to you, which thing is true in Him and in you, because the darkness is passing away, and the true light is already shining. <sup>9</sup>He who says he is in the light, and hates his brother, is in darkness until now. <sup>10</sup>He who loves his brother abides in the light, and there is no cause for stumbling in him. <sup>11</sup>But he who hates his brother is in darkness and walks in darkness, and does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded his eyes. <sup>12</sup>I write to you, little children, Because your sins are forgiven you for His name’s sake. <sup>13</sup>I write to you, fathers, Because you have known Him *who is* from the beginning. I write to you, young men, Because you have overcome the wicked one. I write to you, little children, Because you have known the Father. <sup>14</sup>I have written to you, fathers, Because you have known Him *who is* from the beginning. I have written to you, young men, Because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, And you have overcome the wicked one.

<sup>15</sup>**Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. <sup>16</sup>For all that *is* in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. <sup>17</sup>And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.**
