## October Prayer Requests:

1. Please pray for all who attended the 2018 Reformed Baptist Network General Assembly and the Spanish Post-Conference. Pray that those who attended would be refreshed, and encouraged anew to labor for the sake of the gospel.
2. Trevor Johnson asks for prayers for his health. He was admitted to the Siloam Hospital in Bali due to agonizing pain. It looks to be the effects of chronic malaria. His spleen and liver have been swollen this month after his 23rd case of malaria in 14 years. Doctors have prohibited him from returning to any endemic area until his internal organs return to normal size. The Johnsons are taking several months to rest because they really have no choice. Pray for their health.
