This is the greatest and first commandment. "And a second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' "On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets."

A. No. I have a natural tendency to hate God and my neighbor.

<sup>10</sup>“Therefore you shall love the Lord your God, and keep His charge, His statutes, His judgments, and His commandments always. <sup>2</sup>Know today that *I do* not *speak* with your children, who have not known and who have not seen the chastening of the Lord your God, His greatness and His mighty hand and His outstretched arm— <sup>3</sup>His signs and His acts which He did in the midst of Egypt, to Pharaoh king of Egypt, and to all his land; <sup>4</sup>what He did to the army of Egypt, to their horses and their chariots: how He made the waters of the Red Sea overflow them as they pursued you, and *how* the Lord has destroyed them to this day; <sup>5</sup>what He did for you in the wilderness until you came to this place; <sup>6</sup>and what He did to Dathan and Abiram the sons of Eliab, the son of Reuben: how the earth opened its mouth and swallowed them up, their households, their tents, and all the substance that *was* in their possession, in the midst of all Israel— <sup>7</sup>but your eyes have seen every great act of the Lord which He did.

<sup>28</sup>And now, little children, abide in Him, that when He appears, we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming. <sup>29</sup>If you know that He is righteous, you know that everyone who practices righteousness is born of Him.

<sup>1</sup>Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. <sup>2</sup>Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. <sup>3</sup>And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.
