This is the greatest and first commandment. "And a second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' "On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets."**

A. **No. I have a natural tendency to hate God and my neighbor.**

<sup>8</sup> "Therefore you shall keep every commandment which I command you today, that you may be strong, and go in and possess the land which you cross over to possess, <sup>9</sup> and that you may prolong *your* days in the land which the Lord swore to give your fathers, to them and their descendants, 'a land flowing with milk and honey.' <sup>10</sup> **For the land which you go to possess *is* not like the land of Egypt from which you have come, where you sowed your seed and watered *it* by foot, as a vegetable garden;** <sup>11</sup> **but the land which you cross over to possess *is* a land of hills and valleys, which drinks water from the rain of heaven,** <sup>12</sup> **a land for which the Lord your God cares; the eyes of the Lord your God *are* always on it, from the beginning of the year to the very end of the year.**

**NEW TESTAMENT READING: 1 JOHN 3:7-15** JED JOHNSON

<sup>7</sup> Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous. <sup>8</sup> He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. <sup>9</sup> Whoever has been born of God does not sin, for His seed remains in him; and he cannot sin, because he has been born of God. <sup>10</sup> In this the children of God and the children of the devil are manifest: Whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor *is* he who does not love his brother. <sup>11</sup> For this is the message that you heard from the beginning, that we should love one another, <sup>12</sup> not as Cain *who* was of the wicked one and murdered his brother. And why did he murder him? Because his works were evil and his brother's righteous.
