CALL TO WORSHIP, PSALM 6 PASTOR WOODY

<sup>1</sup> O Lord, do not rebuke me in Your anger, Nor chasten me in Your hot displeasure. <sup>2</sup> Have mercy on me, O Lord, for I am weak; O Lord, heal me, for my bones are troubled. <sup>3</sup> My soul also is greatly troubled; But You, O Lord—how long? <sup>4</sup> **Return, O Lord, deliver me! HEIDELBERG CATECHISM PASTOR WOODY

*Q20. Are all people then saved through Christ just as they were lost through Adam?*

**A. No. Only those are saved who through true faith are grafted into Christ and accept all his benefits.**

*Q 21. What is true faith?*

**A. True faith is not only a sure knowledge by which I hold as true all that God has revealed to us in Scripture; it is also a wholehearted trust, which the Holy Spirit creates in me by the gospel, that God has freely granted, not only to others but to me also, forgiveness of sins, eternal righteousness, and salvation. These are gifts of sheer grace, granted solely by Christ's merit.**

*Q22. What then must a Christian believe?*

**A. All that is promised us in the gospel, a summary of which is taught us in the articles of our universal and undisputed Christian faith.**

*Q23. What are these articles?*

**A. I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only begotten Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was**

***crucified, died, and was buried; he truly died<sup>t</sup>. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended to heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy universal church<sup>t</sup>, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.***

OLD TESTAMENT READING: DEUT 12:20-28 STEVE BARNES

<sup>20</sup> “When the Lord your God enlarges your border as He has promised you, and you say, ‘Let me eat meat,’ because you long to eat meat, you may eat as much meat as your heart desires. <sup>21</sup> If the place where the Lord your God chooses to put His name is too far from you, then you may slaughter from your herd and from your flock which the Lord has given you, just as I have commanded you, and you may eat within your gates as much as your heart desires. <sup>22</sup> Just as the gazelle and the deer are eaten, so you may eat them; the unclean and the clean alike may eat them. <sup>23</sup> Only be sure that you do not eat the blood, for the blood is the life; you may not eat the life with the meat. <sup>24</sup> You shall not eat it; you shall pour it on the earth like water. <sup>25</sup> You shall not eat it, that it may go well with you and your children after you, when you do what is right in the sight of the Lord. <sup>26</sup> Only the holy things which you have, and your vowed offerings, you shall take and go to the place which the Lord chooses. <sup>27</sup> And you shall offer your burnt offerings, the meat and the blood, on the altar of the Lord your God; and the blood of your sacrifices shall be poured out on the altar of the Lord your God, and you shall eat the meat. <sup>28</sup> **Observe and obey all these words which I command you, that it may go well with you and your children after you forever when you do what is good and right in the sight of the Lord your God.**
