

20. The Korties (AZ, Amer. Indians) report that the blanket project has been an overwhelming success, and send thanks. Pray that the Gospel literature that they give with the blankets will be read and that people will find hope in Christ alone.
21. The Emadis (Rep. of Ireland) ask prayer for the salvation of Jo Reilly. Ashley had another good conversation with her about the gospel but she still refuses to believe.
22. Pray for the Selphs (West Atlanta) as they teach the Gospel at the City of Refuge each Friday night and Saturday morning, and then pick ladies and kids up for church each Sunday morning. Pray for their ongoing compassion, wisdom, faith, courage, and the Holy Spirit's power in this work.
23. The Secrests request prayer that God's blessing would be upon the plans being made for the proposed medical mission teams coming to Peru in 2019.
24. Baruch Mazos (Israel) request pray for the final stages in writing his book on church life.
25. Pray for the continued work in Indonesia in spite of the Johnson's absence. Next month, building will begin on a school in Burukmahkot. The nurse, Maikel, and wife, Rosa, left the village to deliver a baby. Imelda also came out for Christmas break but had to take a boat due to inter-clan fighting which closed the trails. The Johnsons are still supporting several teachers, nurses, and bible school students from afar and Trevor is writing articles about their region to the Indonesian media.
26. Throughout 2019, pray with the Ryttersgaards, and Covenant Reformed Baptist Church of Barbados, about purchasing a permanent plot of land.

27. The Baldwins give praise that they completed their second module of the year (Dec 3-7) and were blessed by responses. 3 students have been ordained within the past year and it is encouraging to see the difference between their ministry and the existing churches. The Lord is bringing about a change in Serbia through these young men. Pray that the Lord will raise up many more who will be bold for the truth.
28. Please pray for Pastor Sudarshan's co-pastor (and father in law) Samuel, who continues to have issues with his heart. On a recent visit to Hyderabad to see a specialist, he warned that this could be life threatening. Also, pray for a mild Cyclone season. There was already one in mid-December in which the wind and flooding caused damage to the villages.
29. Please pray that the Lord would provide a godly young French man to serve as intern with David Vaughn in the church plant in the south of France.
30. Please pray that God would open the eyes of many in the new village that the Wells (Italy) are evangelizing, Reana.

## January Prayer Requests:

1. Pray for a special conference focused on reaching Indonesia, to be held January 5 and 6 at Heartland Church, Paducah, KY. Trevor Johnson's co-worker Paul Snider will speak, as well as Matt Glass, who lives in Java, and Kevin Cooney, who is pursuing tribal work in Mentawi island.
2. With the start of the new year approaching, the Baldwins express feeling the time ticking away with their two high school seniors, Graham and Andrew, and ask for wisdom to make decisions about college or job opportunities, back in the States or in Serbia.
3. The Korties (AZ, American Indians) report that they have completed their sweep of the village of Chuichu to introduce themselves. Many were nice, but uninterested. Some were drunk and belligerent. A couple said they are Christians and would like to join them for Bible studies. Pray they will hunger and thirst after righteousness for we know that our Savior will surely fill them.
4. Pastor Obed Rupertus and the church in Santiago, Chile, are rejoicing in God's provision of a larger and better municipal facility at very little additional cost, which will be a huge blessing to the congregation and attract families with young children. Please thank the Lord for answering their prayers, and yours, for them.
5. Please continue to pray that the Emadis (Republic of Ireland) would get their visas. They were supposed to find out the beginning of November and have yet to hear anything.
6. Pray for the people who came to the Christmas worship at the Favre's church (France), that the Lord will work in their heart by His Word that was preached on that day.
7. The economic situation in Argentina continues to create hardships for the saints of the Reformed Baptist Church in Carlos Paz, Argentina. Since God has not yet provided a meeting place they can afford, they continue to meet in the very inadequate home of Pastor Jorge Molina, even as they pray for growth and conversions. Please pray with them.
8. Pray for the Selphs (West Atlanta) as they host a weekly dinner and Bible study. The goal is to keep meeting people in their neighborhood, and then see them come for the study of the Gospel in the Scripture.
9. David Vaughn was scheduled to be in Burkina Faso Jan.11-22 training 170 pastors from an evangelical church in that country. The training has been cancelled because a terrorist attack occurred on Dec.11 in the town where the training has been held up until now. This is the 8<sup>th</sup> attack in the region since August and indicates that Islamic fundamentalist insurgency, which was limited to the north and east of the country has now moved to the east/southeast where David has been training men. Pray for the Church in Burkina Faso, for the pastors who are facing the disruption of their week of training which they looked forward to, and for David and his colleague, Ian as they seek God's wisdom, with the leaders of Pastor Training International, for the way forward.
10. The Mazos (Israel) request pray for Bracha's application for an immigration Visa to the US.
11. Continue to pray for healing for Trevor Johnson (Indonesia). His liver spleen and gallbladder are still enlarged. His thyroid is malfunctioning, his metabolism is worsening due to Chronic Malaria, and his eosinophils are still 5 times the norm. He still is not cleared of all parasites. He can work only a few hours each day until the pain and fatigue are too great.
12. Continue to pray for RuthAnn Wells (Italy), as she recovers from retina surgery. Pray for complete healing, complete restoration of eyesight, and no further complications.
13. The church in Carlos Paz, Argentina, a primarily elderly congregation, is blessed to have a vibrant young couple as recent additions. Please pray for Pastor Jorge Molina's opportunities for counseling other young people and marriages in the community.
14. Larry and Bonnie Secret ask for prayer that the Lord would maintain their church in Barranco, Peru, pure and that the church leadership would have discernment and be protected from the assaults of the evil one.
15. The Favres ask prayer for Daniel Ramesh, a young Tamoul man, who is nearly deaf, as he will start a new school in the beginning of this year. Pray that the Lord will help the Favres to share the Gospel with him in spite of his hearing problem.
16. The Wells (Italy) request prayer for a permanent pastor for their 1-year-old church.
