February Prayer Requests:

1. Pray for the Baldwins regarding their two teenagers who will both be turning 18 in February. There are many decisions to be made about their goals, education and work. They sense the profound need for wisdom in this year of uncertainties and stresses.
2. Rejoice: God's Word has brought to repentance a young couple who began attending the Reformed Baptist Church of Santiago, Chile. Pastor Obed Rupertus requests prayer for several in the congregation who are unemployed as well as others who (due to immigrant status) are working at positions and with salaries far below their training.
3. Pray for Larry Secrest (Lima, Peru) as he preaches today. Pray for the effectiveness of his sermon as well for as for those potential elder candidates who will also be preaching in February.
4. Our brother with a ministry in the Far East requests prayer for God's giving favor with those from whom copyright permissions are needed to get materials required for biblical counseling certification translated and made available online.
5. The Korties have church services in the villages of Chuichu (Sundays) and Ak Chin with the elderly (Wednesdays). John is preaching through the book of Matthew. The Bible is brand new to most of the hearers even though most of them would consider themselves to be Catholic. Pray that the hope of Christ will penetrate the traditions of man.
6. Please pray for the Selph's street outreach as they use Panera Bread "doughnations" to approach people with the love of Christ. Each Saturday they connect with regulars and with brand new people.
7. Olivier Favre requests prayer for the eldership of La Maison de l'Evangile as they meet today to work on a new constitution. Pray for unity and wisdom as they write this important document.
8. From Mark & Cheryl Hatfield in Beijing, China: Pray for the many ex-pat families with children in Beijing. The winter weather and smog negatively affect the health of families, which often causes them to miss Beijing Baptist Church's one main weekly worship service. Pray that parents and children stay well during the winter.
